### Pre-Assessment Services

| Community Coalition<br>Building Meeting      | We host this meeting with formal and<br>informal community leaders who might be<br>interested in championing Communities for<br>Youth work or joining a community coalition.<br>The community coalition supports the<br>Communities for Youth process throughout<br>each step, and can be as formal or informal<br>as needed within the local context. The<br>community coalition is dynamic, and can<br>evolve and grow over time as needed.   | \$2000 for up to<br>two community<br>coalition<br>meetings per<br>district.                      | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Upstream Prevention<br>Training              | This is a training designed for school and<br>community leaders where we teach the<br>basic principles of upstream prevention, our<br>general process, and how it can be an<br>effective tool for improving youth well-<br>being in the community.  | \$2000 for virtual<br>training per<br>school, \$3000<br>for in-person<br>training per<br>school. | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Upstream Prevention<br>Informational Meeting | This is a meeting we host for parents and<br>community members to build an<br>understanding about upstream prevention<br>efforts and the role that data collection and<br>assessments play in supporting youth well-<br>being. The goal of this meeting is to educate<br>the community and to garner support for<br>data collection and upstream prevention<br>efforts.   | \$2000 for virtual<br>meeting per<br>school, \$3000<br>for in-person<br>meeting per<br>school.   | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Community Listening<br>Session               | This session is facilitated by us. In this<br>session, we meet with community members<br>at-large to gather information on their views<br>on youth well-being and ways the<br>community is equipped to address<br>potential risk and protective factors. This<br>information allows school leaders to use the<br>whole community perspective when<br>considering the assessment results,<br>determining actionable goals, and deciding<br>on the best efforts to take for upstream<br>prevention. | \$3500 for in-<br>person meeting<br>per school.  | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |

| School Leaders Data<br>Summary Report Meeting | This meeting is a live review of your data<br>summary report with our data experts. As<br>part of this service, we provide a detailed<br>breakdown and interpretation of the data,<br>including an in-depth discussion of<br>summary results, predictive model results,<br>and assistance in the selection of key data<br>points of interest and key risk and<br>protective factors.  | \$1000 per<br>school for<br>virtual meeting,<br>\$2000 per<br>school for in<br>person<br>meeting. | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Faculty and Staff Data<br>Walk                | This is a meeting hosted by us and designed<br>for teachers and staff who work directly with<br>your students, as well as other leaders at<br>your school. This meeting focuses on a<br>faculty and staff-oriented "data walk" in<br>which we review key data points from the<br>data summary report and investigate<br>relationships between risk and protective<br>factors and youth well-being. As part of this,<br>we provide data visualizations (see below<br>for more information on these). | \$4000 per<br>meeting per<br>school.  | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Student Data Walk                             | This is a meeting hosted by us and designed<br>for students at your school. This meeting<br>focuses on a student-oriented "data walk"<br>in which we review key data points from the<br>data summary report and investigate<br>relationships between risk and protective<br>factors and youth well-being. As part of this,<br>we provide data visualizations (see below<br>for more information on these).  | \$4000 per<br>meeting per<br>school.  | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Whole Community Data<br>Walk                  | We host this meeting, open to the<br>community at-large, to communicate the<br>key data points from the data summary<br>report and gather feedback on the findings.<br>As part of this, we provide data visualizations<br>(see below for more information on these).<br>This meeting is useful for gathering the<br>community perspective on the key data<br>points and risk and protective factors, and<br>for creating 1-2 actionable goals based on<br>community expectations and involvement.   | \$5000 per<br>meeting per<br>school.  | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Community Action Team<br>Meetings             | We host these meetings with the goal of<br>building a collaborative strategic action<br>plan for the community to activate on the<br>selected goals. These meetings are open to<br>the public.  | \$3500 per<br>meeting per<br>school. We<br>suggest at least<br>three meetings<br>a year.          | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |



### Post-Assessment Services Cont'd

| Service provided                                | Description of service  | Fee                            | Notes/Comments  |
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| Student Focus Groups                            | These are structured focus groups<br>conducted by our team with a relatively<br>small group of students to gather more<br>in-depth details on a few key data points.<br>Student focus groups allow for a deeper<br>understanding of the student perspective<br>than the assessment can provide alone,<br>and are useful for gathering more<br>information on key risk and protective<br>factors.  | \$5000 per<br>school.          | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Adult Focus Groups                              | These are structured focus groups<br>conducted by our team with a relatively<br>small group of adults (teachers, staff,<br>parents, and/or other community<br>members) to gather more in-depth<br>details on a few key data points. Adult<br>focus groups allow for a deeper<br>understanding of the perspective of<br>adults in the lives of students, and are<br>useful for gathering more information on<br>key risk and protective factors. | \$5000 per<br>school.          | Dates and location are<br>based on school and<br>district requests. |
| Follow-Up Data Analysis                         | A more customized and in-depth data<br>analysis for schools who want more<br>information than the summary provided.   | \$5000 per<br>school.          |   |
| Data Visualizations for<br>School/Community Use | Our data experts make up to six graphics,<br>provided as presentation slides and/or<br>printed on posters, on key data points.<br>These can be used at the discretion of<br>school leaders for school or community<br>use.  | \$1000 per school.             |   |
| Community Tip Sheets                            | Our research team creates an evidence-<br>based tip sheet focused on one of the<br>community's key risk and protective<br>factors. This tip sheet is useful for sharing<br>with schools, students, parents, and the<br>community at-large to help address an<br>issue and provide actionable and<br>effective information on a chosen risk or<br>protective factor. This is provided as a<br>PDF.   | \$500 per tip<br>sheet factor. |   |



#### Technical Assistance

| Service provided                            | Description of service   | Fee  | Notes/Comments   |
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| As Needed<br>Technical Assistance           | This service includes on-call technical support<br>with our team for questions on upstream<br>prevention efforts. This is useful for school<br>leaders who need minimal on-hands support<br>from us.   | \$450 per month<br>per school, up to<br>five hours per<br>month. | Dates and location are<br>virtual, based on district<br>and school requests.<br>Schools who need more<br>than five hours per<br>month should contact us<br>directly. |
| Full Service Upstream<br>Prevention Package | This service is designed for districts that want<br>to become a <u>Communities for Youth initiative</u> .<br>This service includes all services listed above<br>to empower communities to initiate and<br>sustain actionable upstream prevention<br>strategies for youth well-being. | \$110,000 per<br>district per year.                              |  |
