## Recap of November 28th Boise Action Team Meeting

### **Focus on Social Connection**

Social connection is high-quality, deep relationships in which we can be our authentic selves. We know that social connection is a fundamental human need and human beings are biologically wired for social connection. We also know that lack of social connection is driving depression and suicidal ideation in Boise youth. It's up to us to build more deep, meaningful connections between our kids and themselves, their peers, and other safe, trusted adults. And we can start today.
